Admission into Richmond Avenue Nursery

Thank you for registering your child's details for a nursery place with us.

Every child will be entitled to 15 hours funding the term after their third birthday. To find out if you are entitled to additional hours, 30 hours funding, please visit: www.gov.uk

Please be advised we will only take children in at January & April if we have spaces available after the September intake. This is regardless of how long your child's name has been on the waiting list.

NO spaces can be held during a September intake to allow for spaces later in the year. If we do not have spaces, we may then be able to offer your child a space the following September.

If we are oversubscribed we will use the admissions criteria as follows, in line with the schools admissions policy:

- 1. Looked after children.
- 2. Children who live in the catchment area who have a sibling in the school.
- 3. Children who live in the catchment area.
- 4. Children who live outside area who have a sibling attending the school
- 5. Children who live outside the catchment area. (Catchment area map can be found at www.southend.gov.uk/admissions)

The deadline for applications for September is May 1st each year.

The deadline for applications for January is October 1st each year.


The deadline for applications for April is January 1st each year.
