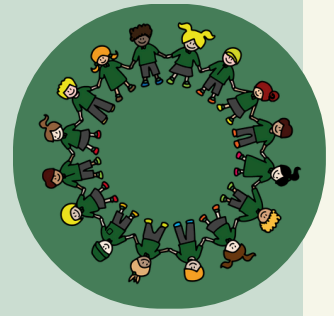

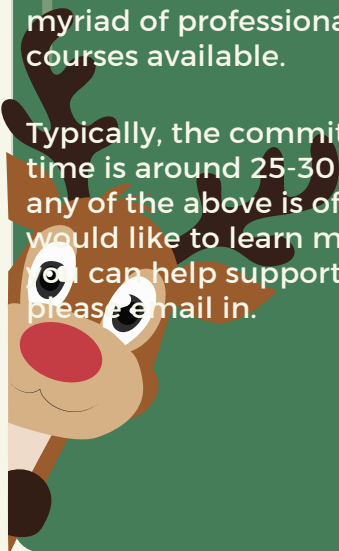

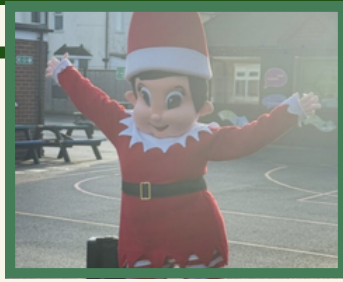


Other News:
