Alongside daily reading practice, we challenge you to also complete the below activities over the half term. For creative or practical tasks, please share photos of your work (if you can't physically bring the items into school).

<p>Practical Use natural materials that you find in your garden or the local park/woods and make a bug hotel for minibeasts to live.</p> <p>Challenge- Can you draw a picture of the minibeasts that you hope are going to use your bug hotel and write a caption for the pictures?</p>	<p>Reading Read everyday for a week- can you pick somewhere exciting and new to read each day? Eg sofa, in a fort, on the stairs, in the garden.</p>	<p>Writing Can you write a sentence about your favourite animal...? 'I love.....' It has/it is.....' Challenge- Can you write a second sentence including the word 'and'?</p>	<p>Practical Can you move your body like different animals? Slither like a snake. Prowl like a lion. Stomp like an elephant. Fly like a bird. Walk like a tall giraffe. Dive like a dolphin.</p>	<p>Maths Can you hunt for the following 3D shapes in your home: cube, cylinder, sphere, cone, cuboid, pyramid? Challenge- Can you write out shape labels to match the objects you have found?</p>
<p>Reading Read a non-fiction book about animals- can you tell an adult a fact that you have learnt?</p> <p>Challenge- Can you write down the fact that you have learnt?</p>	<p>Spelling Play speed tricky words- ask an adult to time one minute for you and see how many times you can write three chosen tricky words. l, no, go, to, the. Challenge- To spell other tricky words such as he, she, we ,me, be, said.</p>	<p>Maths Write numbers 1-20 on individual pieces of paper. Ask an adult to hide these around the house. Can you find them in order, starting from 0? Challenge- Can you ask them adult to hide them again and collect them in reverse order starting from 20?</p>	<p>Writing Ask an adult to give you a word from below- can you tell them a word that rhymes with theirs? When you have thought of a rhyming word can you write it down? Bat, fun, bog, hip, win</p>	<p>Reading Play a game of phonics musical statues. Ask a grown-up to write the digraphs 'll, ff, ss, zz, ck, qu' on pieces of paper. Put some music on and have a dance around. Once the music stops, run to one of them and read the sound. Can you think of a word with that sound in? Challenge- Add in qu, ch, sh, the, ng.</p>
<p>Maths Write numbers 0-10 on individual pieces of paper. Ask an adult to hide five of these around the house. Can you find the number bond partner to the number your adult has given you?</p>	<p>Writing Can you write a sentence to describe this boy?</p> <div style="display: flex; align-items: center;">  <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; display: inline-block;"> <p>Eg: 'He has a big red hat.'</p> </div> </div>	<p>Practical Can you get yourself dressed for school independently, including put your shoes on?</p>	<p>Reading Think of an animal that lives in the jungle- can you draw a picture of them and write a label for it. Can you write a sentence about this animal?</p>	<p>Spelling Ask an adult to give you animal name from below- can you have a go at writing that animal? Cat, hen, fish, dog, crab, fox, pig</p>
<p>Reading Using the pictures attached, ask an adult to write out the digraphs, 'qu, ch, ck, sh'. Can you match the pictures to the digraphs?</p>	<p>Practical Play musical statues with your family- can you make a letter shape with your body when they music stops?</p>	<p>Understanding the world Go for a walk with your family can you take pictures/notes of different animals that you see? Or are their signs that an animal has been there? Eg footprints, feathers etc.</p>	<p>Maths Find a selection of 12 small objects that you can use for counting. An adult is going to give you a number between 1 and 6- can you find the double of the given amount? Challenge- Can you write out the calculations using = and +?</p>	<p>Writing Draw a picture for your friend and write them a message.</p>

<p>Practical Can you create a picture of an animal in their habitat? You could draw/collage/paint it and bring it in to show us!</p>	<p>Maths Using your numbers from 1-20 that you used for a different activity, put them on the floor in a line, in order. You now have your own number line. Ask an adult to give you a number and they are going to ask you to find one more, or one less than the number. Can you jump along your number line and land on the answer?</p>	<p>Reading Read a book of your choice- can you answer the following questions about that book...? Who is the main character? Where is the story set? How did the character feel at the end of the story? What do you think might happen next?</p>	<p>Writing Can you draw the animals that you might find on a farm and in the ocean? Challenge- Can you write the name for each animal you have drawn?</p>	<p>Practical Can you find: A plant without green leaves? A plant growing somewhere unusual eg in a crack of a wall? A plant that is taller than you? A plant that is your favourite colour? Take pictures to share with us.</p>
