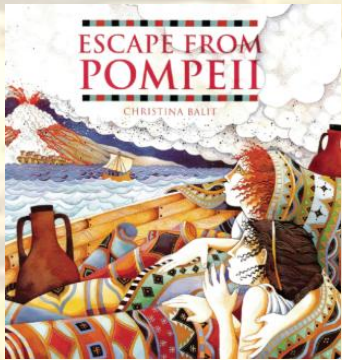


Year 4 Homework Bingo – Summer 1 -A

Science - Create a fact file with no more than 10 facts about a famous scientist.

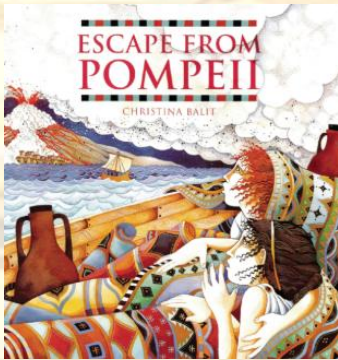
Creative – Design and make a Roman outfit for a slave and/ or a rich person. This could be for your teddy!

History – Research and write 7 facts about Queen Boudica.

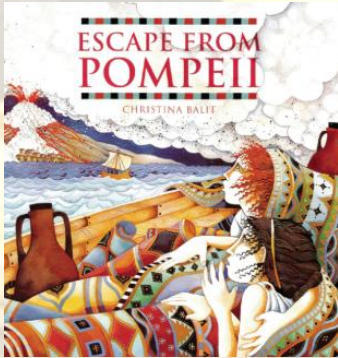
Creative – Design and make a Roman outfit for a slave and/ or a rich person. This could be for your teddy!
