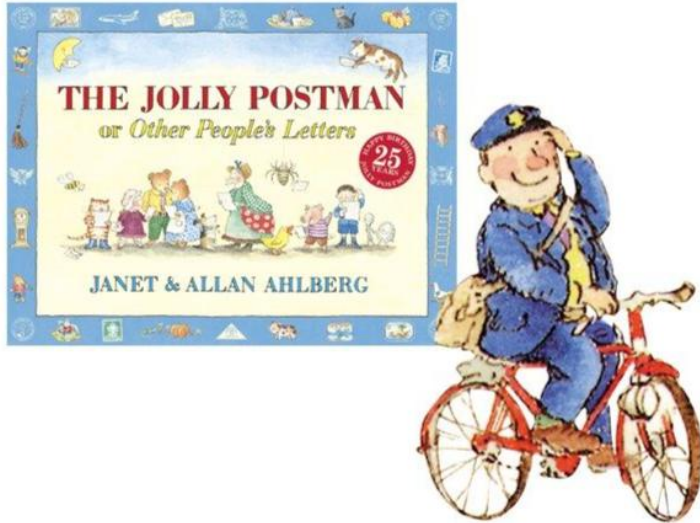


Year 2 Bingo Autumn 1- Marvellous Me/The Jolly Postman.

Alongside daily reading practice, spellings and times tables, we challenge you to also complete the below activities over this half term.

Colour in or tick off each box as you complete them.

Maths - Can you make a fact family using your numbers of people in your family? E.g 2 adults + 3 children. For example: $2 + 3 = 5$ $3 + 2 = 5$ $5 - 2 = 3$ $5 - 3 = 2$	Reading- Read a story with an adult. Choose your favourite character and draw them. Then become a character detective! Write 2 words to describe your character and explain why you chose each word.	Practical -Make your own envelope using a piece of paper. Put a something special inside. <i>Can you design an envelope that is:</i> • <i>strong enough to hold your special item</i> • <i>neatly folded</i> • <i>decorated with a pattern or repeated design?</i>	Writing - Make an alphabet list using things you like such as: A for apples B for bananas C for cars. Can you put your list in alphabetical order? Can you divide the list into categories eg fruit?	Maths - Ask 5 people their favourite colour and make a tally chart. What were the results? Record the most popular colour.	Practical - Make a self-portrait using drawing, painting or collage materials. Include details that show your personality and interests.

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
