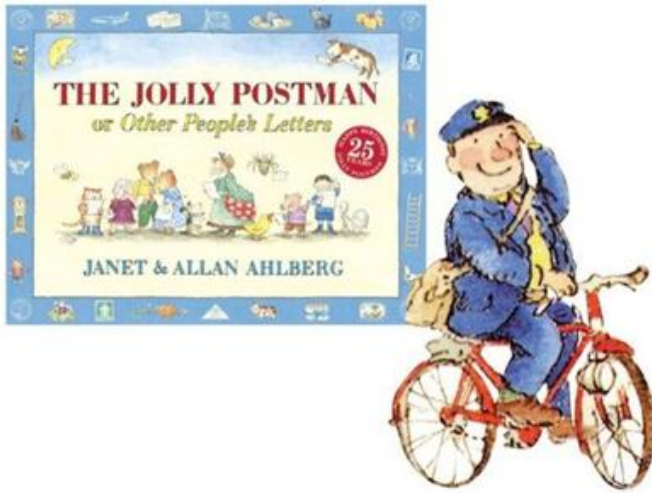


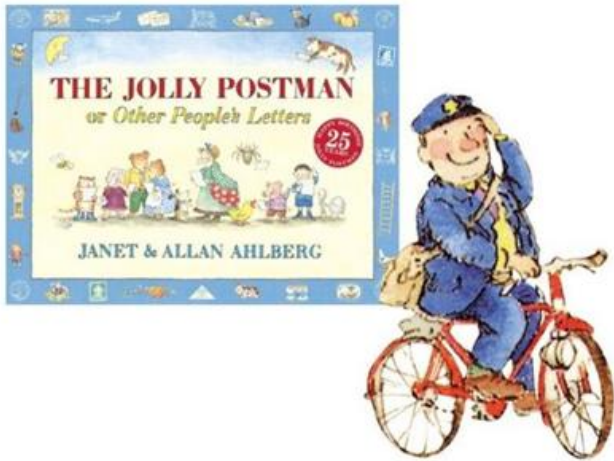
Year 1 Bingo Autumn 1- Marvellous Me/The Jolly Postman.

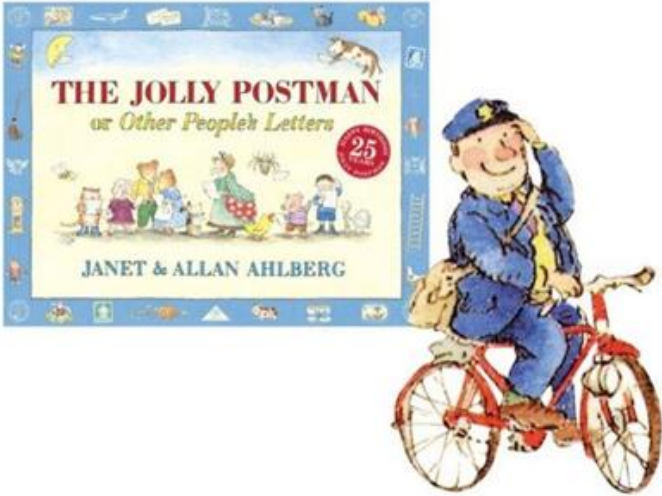
